EPA Fines Illinois Developer \$15,000 for CWA Violations



The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recently issued a complaint ([click here to read](#)) and final order against Illinois' Sharp Homes-Hunter's Ridge Development and Charles D. Sharp for non-compliance with federal storm water regulations. The charges include failure to initiate stabilization measures, prevent or minimize discharges, perform inspections and keep appropriate records. The builder allegedly allowed discharges of storm water and surface runoff to enter a tributary to the Illinois River. A

\$15,000 penalty has been levied.

EPA's Web Tools Shine Public Light on CWA Violators

Think Clean Water Act (CWA) violations can be settled quietly with a fine payment and forgotten? Think again. As part of its commitment to increasing transparency and educating the public about the safety of local waters, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has launched an interactive map and made data available naming CWA violators across the country, as well as in Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands.

Residents and prospective home buyers can do targeted searches to find the names and addresses of violators in their areas, as well as information on number of violations by these companies in the past few years. Cynthia Giles of the EPA says, "Making this information more accessible and understandable empowers millions of people to press for better compliance and enforcement in their communities."
